GUIDELINES FOR LETTERS:

1. it should be a letter, not a short note card

4. What to say is up to you but should include congratulations, regrets for how their year ended, best wishes for the future, the need to choose to follow Jesus, etc.
5. sign your name (suggested, but optional)
6. include our church name
7. place letter in an **unsealed** envelope – we hope to find an appropriate tract to include
8. pray for the student(s) that will receive your letter(s) – (feel free to write more than one!)

Completed letters should be dropped off at the church office or to Elyse Griffin (809-2835) by June 1st. (Bear Grass graduation is May 26th so we will accept letters by May 20th if some are ready!). Thank you for your help!
