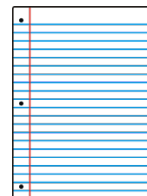


Western NC Hurricane Relief Mission Trip – October 9th-11th

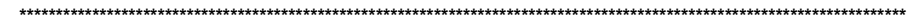

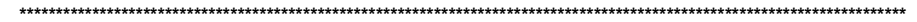

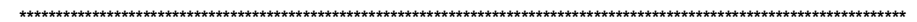
