Last school year, our combined efforts in Martin County met (and exceeded!) our goal of raising \$25,000 to support 155 children in this program with a bag of food each weekend. We want to thank each and every one of you for your support from the ‘bottom of our backpacks’!!

This year our goal is to sustain this level of support by raising \$25,000 county-wide.
